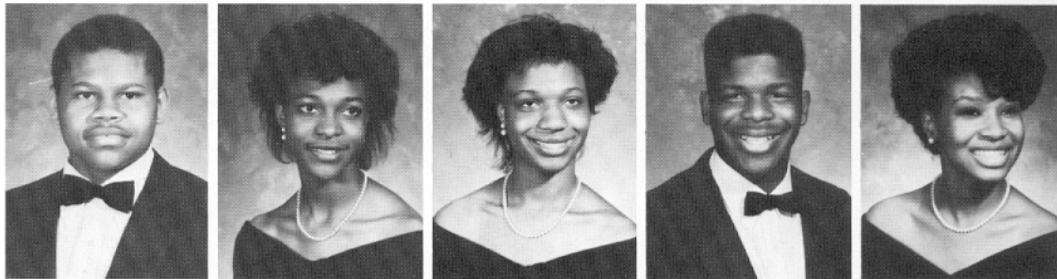


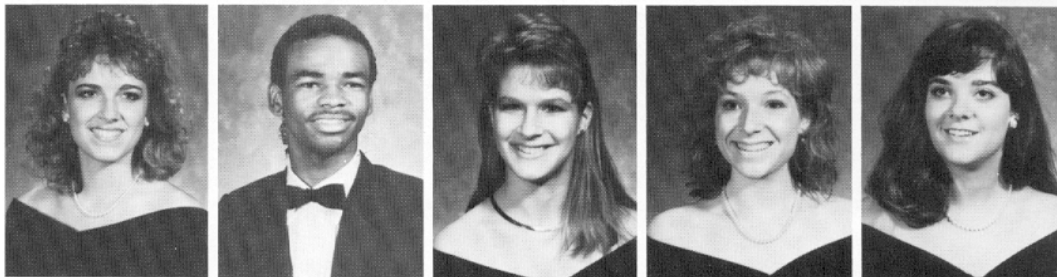

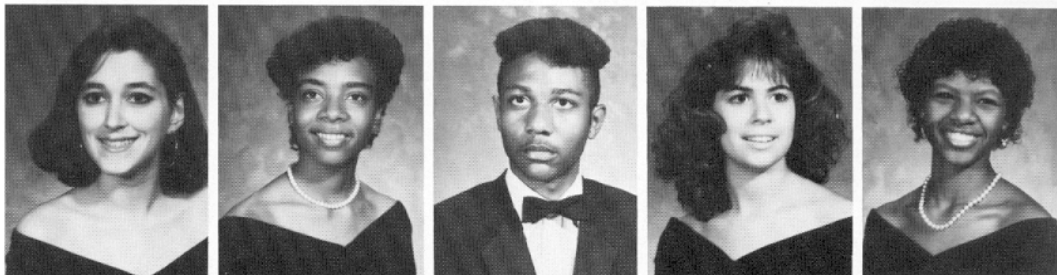

Flying High

Senior says he enjoys 'flying around' state; featured in paper's first high school section

Senior Blair Allen did lots of flying during the 1987-88 school year.

He took flying lessons at Central Flying Service so that he could obtain a pilot's license by the time he got his high school diploma.

His interest in gaining a pilot's license caught the eyes of the editors at the **Arkansas Democrat**, who selected him to be featured on the first page of the first high school section they ever published, called "High School Times." The high school section appeared on September 18, 1987, and contained news from all the high schools in Pulaski County.

Allen's father owns an airplane that he uses for business. "That is what got me interested in flying," Allen said.

Allen said it cost about \$2,500 to take the necessary instruction to obtain a pilot's license. "It's worth every cent too," he said.

"It's lots of fun," Allen said about flying. "More fun than driving a car."
